Saturday 22nd April at 10am all performers are to be at the school hall for a dress rehearsal please come as you will on Sunday

No parents are allowed in the hall except for the Competition Team Managers who need to be present.

Term 2:

AUCKLAND: mini showcase at the Botany Town Centre proposed date is Saturday 15th July outside the food court around lunch time. Time TBC (Week 1 of term 2 school holidays)

A rehearsal will be held on Monday 3rd of July 5.30 – 6.30pm

CAMBRIDGE: mini showcase at Centre Place proposed date is Friday 14th July around lunch time. Time and where exactly TBC (Week 1 of term 2 school holidays)

A dress rehearsal will be held on Saturday 8th of July 5 – 6pm

CHRISTCHURCH: mini showcase at The Palms Saturday 8th July **outside Kmart** around lunch time. Time TBC

A dress rehearsal will be held Friday 7th July 3.30 – 4.30pm

Please let us know if you are unable or do not want to be a part of these performances

You will all need Jete Dance uniform (any styles) and black shoes for the performance. Girl's hair must be securely tied up off face and any style is acceptable

Uniforms

Everyone must be wearing at least one piece of uniform to every class. Exams students will also need required items to sit their exam. I will be placing an order at the end of term 1. Orders need to be placed with myself or your teacher before Sunday 16th April. The order takes 6 -8 weeks to arrive so will be available in time for our mid- year show.

End of year Exams and Medal Awards

Exams and Medal awards proposed dates are **AUCKLAND 1 – 31st August** and **Cambridge August 15 – 31st**
Christchurch has a confirmed dated of Sunday 3rd September

Medal Awards are \$40 and Junior Exams \$65 and Major exams \$95 (includes admin fee)

All exam and medal fees will be added to your term 2 account. If you don't wish to sit exam and or medal please let your teacher know before the end of term 1.

Medal award is not compulsory but we strongly recommend that your child takes part. A Medal award is aimed at encouraging students to dance, allowing them to perform in front of an audience in a fun atmosphere. This can help lead them towards the examination system if doing exams and for the non-exam classes, performance is important at all levels and for all styles. Some costuming or "dress up" is encouraged, but is optional. Makeup and accessories may be used. These all add to the sense of fun and performance intended with these medals.

Students are presented with their medals by the examiner on the same day as their performance. A report card will also be completed by the examiner.

NEW - Musical Theatre Award

You must be over 9 years old and must also give a brief narration explaining the musical story line and style they will be dancing plus how their character fits into it

Vocals or lip-sync options

NEW - Group Medal - \$25 per person

Minimum of 4 students – Only one award/level for this but you can enter as many time as you like over the years/disciplines
