A rehearsal will be held on Saturday 8th of July 5 – 6pm

CHRISTCHURCH: mini showcase at The Palms proposed date is Saturday 8th July **outside Kmart** around lunch time. Time TBC (last week of term 2)
A Rehearsal will be held the week before time and day TBC

End of year Exams and Medal Awards

Exams and Medal awards proposed dates are **AUCKLAND 1 – 31st August** and **Cambridge August 15 – 31st Christchurch has a confirmed dated of Sunday 3rd December**

Medal Awards are \$40 and Junior Exams \$65 and Major exams \$95 (includes admin fee)

All exam and medal fees will be added to your term 2 account. If you don't wish to sit exam and or medal please let your teacher know before the end of term 1.

Medal Awards

Medal award is not compulsory but we strongly recommend that your child takes part. A Medal award is aimed at encouraging students to dance, allowing them to perform in front of an audience in a fun atmosphere. This can help lead them towards the examination system if doing exams and for the non-exam classes, performance is important at all levels and for all styles. Some costuming or "dress up" is encouraged, but is optional. Makeup and accessories may be used. These all add to the sense of fun and performance intended with these medals.

Students are presented with their medals by the examiner on the same day as their performance. A report card will also be completed by the examiner.

Music

Any dancers that would like their music to practice at home can hand in a usb stick or a blank CD (with your name on the cover) to your teacher.

Parents

Reminder all parents with children aged 6 years or older are not to stay during class time. Every last week of term we will have a viewing day were all parents, friends and family can come view what they have been up to for the term. Your teacher has the right to ask you to leave if you do not action this.

Please all note that any invoices that have not had a payment plan organised and no payment towards them will be receiving a late fee. Invoices will be issued the first week of term and to be paid by following week unless prior arrangement has been made
